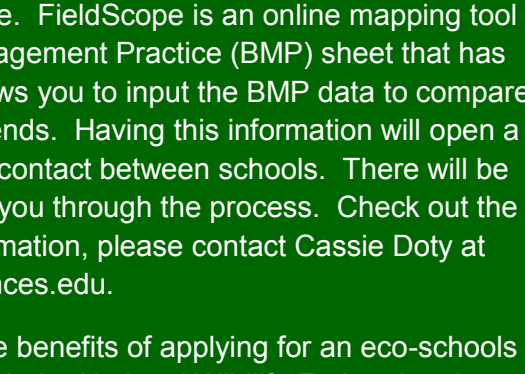

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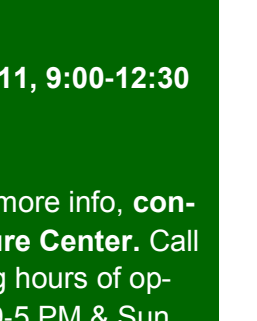
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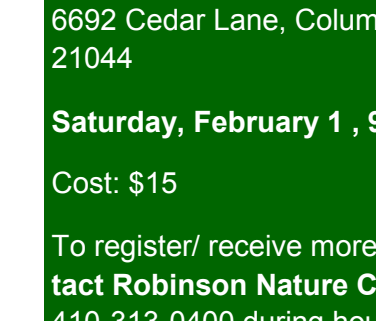
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MAEOE's Featured School



Tanglewood Regional School

Tanglewood Regional School, located in Clinton, Maryland, succeeded in receiving their 1st Green School recertification in 2013. Among their list of top 5 accomplishments are their Recycling program and Adaptation of Environmental/Outdoor Education for students with disabilities. Tanglewood students regularly reuse everyday materials to express themselves artistically. Some of their most recent examples include mobiles made from used cutlery, school buses made from egg cartons, a water bottle "crazy tree" and aluminum foil "freedom bells". Tanglewood's PTO and Andrews Air Force Base personnel work together on a variety of projects including the recycling of cans, plastic, paper and ink cartridges. Students participated in a "Recycle Relay" during a Courageous Pacers event. Courageous Pacers is a monthly activity aimed at increasing movement opportunities for the students.
