2023-2024 Teacher Stipend for Leading a Green Team or Other School Club

Grant Specifics

Funding Range:

- **Stipend Amount: \$250**
- **Please view the "2023-2024 Funding Opportunities from MAEOE" presentation prior to completion of the grant application. Viewing this presentation is a requirement to apply for this grant. *See Page 2 for more information.***

Eligibility Requirements:

- **Be a teacher or staff member at any Maryland public or private school (*your school does NOT have to be a current Green School to be eligible*).**
- **Lead a youth Green Team or any school club.**
- **Student-driven sustainability project must occur in Maryland.**

Funding Guidelines:

- **An award agreement must be reviewed and signed.**
- **Teacher or staff must meet with the Green Team or school club *at least three times* within the grant timeframe.**
- **A student-driven sustainability project must be submitted by April 12, 2024 (*projects accepted on a rolling basis through this date; teachers submitting projects after this date run the risk of not receiving the stipend*).**
- **2024 Media/Publicity Release Form (available in Spanish and English) must be completed and signed for each student whose facial image is used in the final student-driven sustainability project (*teachers not submitting media/publicity release forms may not be granted the stipend*).**
- **One teacher per school will be given a stipend.**
- **No W9 Form is needed.**
- **Limited funds are available. Stipends will be granted until all funds are distributed.**

Project Expectations:

- **Project is required to be student-driven and centered around "green" sustainability practices.**
- **Documentation of the project can include presentation slides, videos, photos, virtual posters, or another creative way of sharing ideas. View examples.**
- **Questions to get your started:**
 - **How does your school strive to be green?**
 - **How can you help to elevate the voice of impacted communities?**

- **How can you be part of the journey in addressing climate change?**

Distribution of Funds:

- **Stipend will be distributed after all signatures on the award agreement are received and the student-driven sustainability project is submitted.**
- **2024 Media/Publicity Release Form must be completed and signed for each student whose facial image is used in the final student-driven sustainability project prior to stipend being distributed.**
- **You will not receive any tax information documents at the end of the year since the stipend does not exceed \$600**
